

SAFE APP (GSA) Privacy Policy

Last updated: Sept 29, 2022

This Privacy Policy describes Our policies and procedures on the collection, use and disclosure of Your information when You use the Galway Safe App (GSA) and tells You about Your privacy rights and how the law protects You.

We use Your Personal data to provide and improve the Galway Safe App (GSA). By using the Galway Safe App (GSA), You agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy has been created with the help of the [Privacy Policy Generator](#).

Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

The words of which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions. The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

Account means a unique account created for You to access the Galway Safe App (GSA).

Affiliate means an entity that controls, is controlled by or is under common control with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity interest or other securities entitled to vote for election of directors or other managing authority.

Application means the software program provided by the Company downloaded by You on any electronic device, named Galway Safe app

Company (referred to as either "the Company", "We", "Us" or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to Western Region Drug and Alcohol Task Force, 18 Tuam Road, Galway H91 R65V.

Country refers to: Ireland

Device means any device that can access the Service such as a computer, a cellphone or a digital tablet.

Personal Data is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.

Service refers to the Application.

Service Provider means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the Company. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by the Company to facilitate the Galway Safe App (GSA), to provide the Galway Safe App (GSA) on behalf of the Company, to perform services related to the Galway Safe App (GSA) or to assist the Company in analyzing how the Galway Safe App (GSA) is used.

Usage Data refers to data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the Galway Safe App (GSA) or the infrastructure of the Galway Safe App (GSA) itself (for example, the duration of a visit to the app).

You means the individual accessing or using the Galway Safe App (GSA), or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Galway Safe App (GSA), as applicable.

Collecting and Using Your Personal Data

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

While using the Galway Safe App (GSA), We may ask You to provide Us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify You. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

Phone number

Usage Data

Name

Location data

Usage Data

Usage Data is collected automatically when using the Galway Safe App (GSA).

Usage Data may include information such as Your Device's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), the sections of the Galway Safe App (GSA) that You visit, the time and date of Your visit, the time spent using the Galway Safe App (GSA), unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

When You access the Galway Safe App (GSA) by or through a mobile device, We may collect certain information automatically, including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device You use, Your mobile device unique ID, the IP address of Your mobile device, Your mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser You use, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information that Your browser sends whenever You access the Galway Safe App (GSA) by or through a mobile device.

Location data: Information Collected while Using the Galway Safe app

While using the Galway Safe App (GSA), in order to provide features of the Galway Safe App (GSA), We may collect, with Your prior permission:

Information regarding your location

We use this information to provide features of Galway Safe App (GSA), to improve and customize the Galway Safe App (GSA). The information may be

uploaded to the Company's servers and/or a Service Provider's server or it may be simply stored on Your device.

You can enable or disable access to this information at any time, through Your Device settings.

SMS

We use android.permission.SEND_SMS, for physical safety / emergency alerts to be sent by SMS, and android.permission.READ_CONTACTS for adding contacts to your list of emergency contacts.

Location Information

Location information is also provided to your 'In Case of Emergency' or ICE contacts so friends, family and in extreme cases Emergency Services can be alerted to ensure your safety. You have the option to share your location data with these parties before you first use the application. The option to share location information with the parties stated above is only possible if the option to always track location is selected even when the application is not open. This ensures that the user does not need to think about running or launching the application so user input can be minimal. It is also the case that the location information is only shared with the parties named above at certain times of the day or night. So for example it maybe the case that this is only captured between 12 midnight and 6 o'clock in the morning.

The information that we request will be retained by us and used as described in this privacy policy.

The app does use third party services that may collect information used to identify you.

Use of Your Personal Data

The Company may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

To provide and maintain our Service, including to monitor the usage of the Galway Safe App (GSA)

To manage Your Account: to manage Your registration as a user of the Galway Safe App (GSA) . The Personal Data You provide can give You access to different functionalities of the Galway Safe App (GSA) that are available to You as a registered user.

For the performance of a contract: the development, compliance and undertaking of the purchase contract for the products, items or services You have purchased or of any other contract with Us through the Galway Safe App (GSA) .

To contact You: To contact You by email, telephone calls, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication, such as a mobile application's push notifications regarding updates or informative communications related to the functionalities, products or contracted services, including the security updates, when necessary or reasonable for their implementation.

To provide You with news and general information about other services and events which we offer that are similar to those that you have already enquired about.

To manage Your requests: To attend and manage Your requests to Us.

For business transfers: We will not use Your information to evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which Personal Data held by Us about our Service users is among the assets transferred.

For other purposes: We will not use Your information for other purposes, such as determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns and to evaluate and improve the Galway Safe App (GSA), products, services, marketing and your experience.

How we will use Your personal information:

With Service Providers: We will only share Your personal information with Service Providers to monitor and analyze the use of the Galway Safe App (GSA),

to contact You. It will be limited to data that is gathered and used only in the user's best interests and with their full permission.

For business transfers: We will only share or transfer Your personal information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of Company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of Our business to another company. It will be limited to data that is gathered and used only in the user's best interests and with their full permission.

With Affiliates: We will only share Your information with Our affiliates, in which case we will require those affiliates to honor this Privacy Policy. Affiliates include Our parent company and any other subsidiaries, joint venture partners or other companies that We control or that are under common control with Us. It will be limited to data that is gathered and used only in the user's best interests and with their full permission.

With business partners: We will only share Your information with Our business partners to offer You certain products, services or promotions. It will be limited to data that is gathered and used only in the user's best interests and with their full permission.

With other users: when You share personal information or otherwise interact in the public areas with other users, such information may be viewed by all users and may be publicly distributed outside.

Retention of Your Personal Data

The Company will retain Your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use Your Personal Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

The Company will also retain Usage Data for internal analysis purposes. Usage Data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of the Galway

Safe App (GSA), or We are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

Transfer of Your Personal Data

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at the Company's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. It means that this information may be transferred to - and maintained on - computers located outside of Your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from Your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by Your submission of such information represents Your agreement to that transfer.

The Company will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that Your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of Your Personal Data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of Your data and other personal information.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data

Business Transactions

If the Company is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, Your Personal Data may be transferred but *only* with your consent. We will provide notice before Your Personal Data is transferred and becomes subject to a different Privacy Policy.

Law enforcement

Under certain circumstances, the Company may be required to disclose Your Personal Data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g. a court or a government agency).

Other legal requirements

The Company may disclose Your Personal Data in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to:

Comply with a legal obligation

Protect and defend the rights or property of the Company

Prevent or investigate possible wrongdoing in connection with the Service

Protect the personal safety of Users of the Service or the public

Protect against legal liability

Security of Your Personal Data

The security of Your Personal Data is important to Us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While We strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect Your Personal Data, We cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Children's Privacy

The Galway Safe App (GSA) does not address anyone under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 13. If You are a parent or guardian and You are aware that Your child has provided Us with Personal Data, please contact Us. If We become aware that We have collected Personal Data from anyone under the age of 13 without verification of parental consent, We take steps to remove that information from Our servers.

If We need to rely on consent as a legal basis for processing Your information and Your country requires consent from a parent, We may require Your parent's consent before We collect and use that information.

Links to Other Websites

The Galway Safe App (GSA) may contain links to websites that are not operated by Us. If You click on a third party link, You will be directed to that third party's site. We strongly advise You to review the Privacy Policy of every site You visit.

We have no control over and assume no responsibility for the content, privacy policies or practices of any third party sites or services.

Changes to this Privacy Policy

We may update Our Privacy Policy from time to time. We will notify You of any changes by posting the new Privacy Policy on this page.

We will let You know via email and/or a prominent notice on the Galway Safe App (GSA), prior to the change becoming effective and update the "Last updated" date at the top of this Privacy Policy.
